I join the meeting so I can see my teacher who will be there to discuss the learning for this Learning Session.

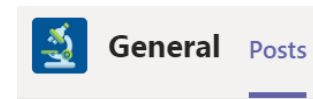


Now I've got an activity to work on, so in OneNote I'm going to complete the activity – or – I might write it in my workbook and post a photo to my OneNote Notebook.

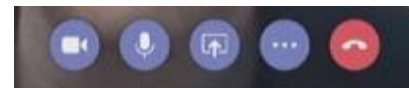


My teacher can see what I am doing in my OneNote Notebook as I do it. And they can add to my Notebook as well.
